

ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE ~~xxx~~ relating to the sale and consumption of liquor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, other than a regular licensed drug store, to sell or offer for sale, any liquor containing more than 22% alcohol by volume, in the Town of Redmond.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any drug store in the Town of Redmond to sell or offer for sale, any liquor containing more than 22% alcohol by volume except in the original container.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any ~~irregular~~ person to drink any liquor containing more than 22% alcohol by volume on the premises where liquor is sold, on any street, or in any public building or public place in the Town of Redmond.

Section 4. Any person violating any provision of the ORDINANCE shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00, or thirty days in jail, or both.
