RESOLUTION NO. 719

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DESIGNATING THE JOURNAL-AMERICAN AS THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE CITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PUBLISHING ORDINANCES AND LEGAL NOTICES, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 713.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond is an optional municipal code city organized under the provisions of Title 35A RCW, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 469, Laws of 1985, requires each code city to designate an official newspaper by resolution for the purpose of publishing ordinances and other notices required to be published by law, and

WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution No. 713 on August 6, 1985, the City Council designated The Sammamish Valley News, published on a weekly basis, as the City's official newspaper, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is preferable to designate a daily newspaper as the City's official newspaper in order to avoid delay, expense and inconvenience which will be caused by publishing notices on a weekly, rather than daily basis, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that The Journal-American is a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Redmond and has the qualifications prescribed by Chapter 65.16 RCW and Chapter 469, Laws of 1985 for official newspapers, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Journal-American is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the City of Redmond for the purpose of publishing ordinances and other notices required to be published by law.

Section 2. Resolution No. 713, passed by the City Council on August 6, 1985, which designated The Sammamish Valley News as the City's official newspaper is hereby repealed.
