

RESOLUTION NO. 732

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING PASSAGE OF STATE
LEGISLATION PERTAINING TO THE SECURING OF LOADS AND
CLEANING OF TRUCKS BEFORE DRIVING ON PUBLIC ROADS.

WHEREAS, Cheryl Ann Braid of Redmond was killed December
9, 1985 by a large rock that was possibly dropped from and/or kicked
up by a truck on State Route 520 within the City of Redmond, and

WHEREAS, there have been numerous broken windshields and
other damage resulting in injuries and increased insurance rates
due to rocks coming from trucks, and

WHEREAS, there is a large volume of truck traffic in Redmond
due to the I-90 construction project and increased development,
and,

WHEREAS, there is a large amount of community concern for
personal safety while traveling our roads demonstrated by testimony
before the council by numerous citizens, and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond considers
public safety a top priority, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. To urge the prompt passage of state legislation
to require truckers to cover their loads and to clean truck under-
carriages before driving on public roads.
