RESOLUTION NO. 741

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 550 WHICH DECLARED POLICY REGARDING DEVELOPMENT OF THE MAINGATE AREA OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, on August 5, 1980, the Redmond City Council adopted Resolution No. 550, declaring City policy for the development of the Maingate Area of the City, and specifically favoring development of a comparison goods shopping complex within a specified portion of the Maingate Area, and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of Resolution No. 550, the City has engaged in a process of land use policy formulation intended to take into consideration the potential alternative sites for a regional scale comparison goods shopping complex within the City, and

WHEREAS, the policy favoring a specific site for such development expressed in Resolution No. 550 is not consistent with the City's present land use policymaking process which has resulted in the identification of the Redmond Town Center property and the adjacent property known as the Butler-Walls property, as the potential site for such development, and therefore it is appropriate that Resolution No. 550 be repealed, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVE that City of Redmond Resolution No. 550, passed by the City Council on August 5, 1980, be, and hereby is, repealed.
