RESOLUTION NO. 756

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, CONCERNING STAFF ASSISTANCE TO CITIES SELECTED AS POTENTIAL SOLID WASTE INCINERATION SITES.

WHEREAS, the Suburban Cities Association is on record as supporting incineration plants as one strategy to address the management of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, there is need to display a regional concern to a regional problem; and

WHEREAS, the suburban cities' strength is gained by cooperation, support, and assistance to its membership; and

WHEREAS, the cost of incineration plants must include mitigation costs for those jurisdictions impacted by the plant's location;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT member cities selected as potential incineration sites may be provided staff assistance of other member cities to help ensure their interests are protected; that appropriate concessions based on city needs are provided; and while the solution to the garbage disposal issue is an important regional issue, that county-wide economic considerations should also be balanced against city economic and environmental considerations.
