

RESOLUTION NO. 760

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF REDMOND REGARDING CURRENT
AND FUTURE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS WITH
THE CITY OF KIRKLAND

WHEREAS, in April, 1984, the Kirkland City Council passed Resolution R-3096, establishing 132nd Avenue NE as the ultimate eastern boundary of future annexations of the City of Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, in May, 1984, the Redmond City Council passed Resolution 675, affirming the City of Redmond's intent not to consider annexations west of 132nd Avenue NE; and

WHEREAS, February, 1987, the City of Kirkland received a letter of understanding from the City of Redmond establishing Redmond's agreement to participate in funding of major street improvements in those areas of 132nd Avenue NE that abut the City of Redmond; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland is proposing two annexations which, if approved, will bring the Kirkland City limit to the east side of the 132nd Avenue NE right-of-way; and the City of Redmond is proposing to annex areas east of 132nd Ave. NE;

WHEREAS, portions of property located east of 132nd Avenue NE, located in the City of Redmond Planning Area, will remain in unincorporated King County for an undetermined time; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond seeks to work cooperatively with King County and adjacent cities to ensure the fair and efficient delivery of emergency services in and around the City of Redmond; and

WHEREAS, major development proposals in Kirkland or Redmond may have impacts that extend into adjacent cities.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Redmond as follows:

- Section 1: The Redmond City Council hereby reaffirms that 132nd Avenue NE is the ultimate western boundary of the City of Redmond.
- Section 2: If annexations bringing 132nd Avenue NE right-of-way into the City of Kirkland are approved, City staff are directed to work cooperatively with the City of Kirkland on future design and funding of improvements to 132nd Avenue NE.
- Section 3: The Redmond City Council directs staff to work cooperatively with King County and the City of Kirkland to ensure fair and efficient emergency services to any remaining unincorporated areas adjacent to the Cities of Redmond and Kirkland.

Section 4: The Redmond City Council directs staff to work with the City of Kirkland to develop reciprocal review and mitigation procedures for projects that may have impacts beyond each City's incorporated limits.
