RESOLUTION NO. 766

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DECLARING THAT MAINTENANCE OF AN INDEX IDENTIFYING ALL PUBLIC INFORMATION AND RECORDS HELD BY THE CITY WOULD BE UNDULY BURDENSOME AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH INDEX WILL NOT BE MAINTAINED.

WHEREAS, RCW 42.17.260 requires every public agency to maintain and make available for public inspection and copying a current index providing identifying information as to certain public records, except where maintaining such an index would be unduly burdensome or would interfere with agency operations, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond and it's employees generate or obtain thousands of documents each year which would fit within the categories required to be indexed by RCW 42.17.260, which the City Council has determined would create an unreasonable and undue burden on the City to index and would substantially interfere with the operations of the City of Redmond because of the time necessary to index the multitude of records, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Index Not to be Maintained. Pursuant to RCW 42.17.260, the City Council of the City of Redmond hereby declares that the indexing and maintaining an index of all public records obtained by the City would be unduly burdensome and would interfere with the operations of the City. A current index as described in RCW 42.17.260 will therefore not be maintained by the City.

Section 2. Duties of City Clerk. The City Clerk shall continue to make available for public inspection and copying all existing indexes maintained for use by the City of Redmond.

Section 3. Publication. This Resolution shall be published  
in the official newspaper of the City of Redmond.
