

An ordinance licensing shows, carnivals, and circuses in the Town of Redmond, fixing the license fee therefor and fixing the penalty for the violation thereof.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond.

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any individual or individuals, partnerships or companies to engage in exhibitions, shows, circuses or carnivals in the Town of Redmond without having procured a license therefor.

Sec. 2. The license fee for circuses or carnivals shall be \$2.00 for each day or part of a day that the circus or carnival is on exhibition.

Sec. 3. The license fee for any show held indoors or out in the open shall be \$2.00 for each day or part of a day that it is on exhibition to the public.

Sec. 4 It shall be unlawful to place any show, carnival or circus on exhibition in the Town of Redmond that is obscene, degrading or that tends to corrupt the public morals.

Sec. 5 The Town Clerk shall issue a receipt for all moneys or fees collected from all qualified exhibitors of shows, carnivals or circuses which receipt shall state the day or days on which such shows, carnivals or circuses are to be held.

Sec. 6 Nothing in this ordinance shall prevent schools, churches, religious organizations or local Fraternities from exhibiting shows, carnivals or circuses in the Town of Redmond without having procured a license therefor.

Any one failing to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than \$25.00 or imprisoned in the Town Jail for not more than 10 days or both such fine and imprisonment.
