RESOLUTION NO. 792

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REALLOCATING A PORTION OF THE 1989 BLOCK GRANT FUNDS IN ORDER TO ENSURE FUNDING TO THE MULTI-SERVICE CENTERS OF NORTH AND EAST KING COUNTY.

WHEREAS, in September of 1988 the City Council determined that certain 1989 proposed projects would be funded from the City's Block Grant Funds, including an allocation of \$25,000 to the Multi-Service Centers of North and East King County to pay for a two-year lease for a food bank, and

WHEREAS, subsequently, HUD issued a ruling which prohibits funding for leases of less than a fifteen year duration, and

WHEREAS, through consultations with King County, it has been determined that King County is willing to fund the two-year food bank lease if the City will reallocate \$25,000 of its Block Grant Funds to pay for development of Springwood Park, and it has been determined that the Springwood Park development project is eligible to receive funding from the City's Block Grant Funds, now, therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The sum of \$25,000 is hereby reallocated from the Multi-Service Center lease project to the King County Springwood Park development project in consideration of agreement by King County to fund the Multi-Service Center food bank lease for a period of two years.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the reallocation and to ensure funding of the food bank lease project by King County.
