

RESOLUTION NO. 815

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING THE
PASSAGE OF THE CHILDREN'S INITIATIVE (#102)

WHEREAS, the Children's Initiative is a statewide ballot measure calling for increased state funding for the health, protection, and education of Washington's children, and

WHEREAS, the Children's Initiative will provide \$360 million above current spending levels for children's health and protection services and K-12 education, and

WHEREAS, the Children's Initiative reaffirms our state's commitment to children by creating a designated Trust Fund to be spent only on children, and

WHEREAS, a citizens oversight committee will be appointed to ensure expenditures are consistent with the initiative's intent, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY RESOLVES that:

Section 1. The City Council should, and hereby does express its support for the passage of the initiative, and that,

Section 2. If passed, the legislature should look seriously and inventively for an ongoing funding source other than the sales tax.
