

RESOLUTION NO. 819

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
DIRECTING THE USE OF RECYCLED PAPER

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond currently uses paper derived from virgin pulp, and

WHEREAS, recycled paper is competitively available, and

WHEREAS, in order to complete the cycling of recycled paper it must be purchased and reused, and

WHEREAS, further savings can be accomplished by using both sides of recycled paper, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond is asking its citizens to initiate a household recycling program in early 1990, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, wishes to demonstrate to the citizens of Redmond its commitment to recycling.

As a first step, the City Council directs the Mayor and the City of Redmond Administration to utilize recycled paper and to utilize two-sided copying whenever operationally feasible in all future City publications, letters, documents, and memos.

FURTHERMORE, the City is to inform the public of this ecologic savings. In the bottom margin of all future City publications, letters, documents, and memos on recycled

paper, Redmond shall declare its commitment to resources by stating:

Redmond Recycled Paper.
