

ORDINANCE NO: 2062

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, SETTING FIREFIGHTER SALARIES
FOR 1999 AND 2000.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond agreed through the collective bargaining process to grant an across the board increase in 1999 and 2000 to uniformed employees represented by the Redmond Firefighters Union; and,

WHEREAS, these changes should now be reflected by amending the respective pay plans; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pay Plan "D" is hereby amended to grant a three percent (3%) increase in salaries effective January 1, 1999, for members of the Redmond Firefighters Union, over rates of pay in effect on December 31, 1998, adopted by Ordinance No. 1972, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 2. Pay Plan "D" is hereby amended to grant a one and six ^{scrivener's} ~~error~~ ~~tenths-hundredths~~ percent (1.066%) increase in salaries effective April 1, 1999, for employees in the classifications of Firefighter and Driver/Operator, over rates of pay in effect on March 31, 1999, adopted under Section 1 of this ordinance, as set forth in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 3. Pay Plan "D" is hereby amended to grant a two and forty-six one hundredth percent (2.46%) increase in salaries effective April 1, 1999, for employees in the classifications of Lieutenant, Fire Inspector, Captain, Assistant Fire Marshall, and

Fire Marshall, over rates of pay in effect on March 31, 1999, as adopted under Section 1 of this ordinance, as set forth in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 4. Pay Plan "D" is hereby amended to grant a two and eight tenths percent (2.8%) increase in salaries effective January 1, 2000, for members of the Redmond Firefighters Union, over rates of pay in effect on December 31, 1999, adopted under Section 2 and Section 3 of this ordinance, plus an additional one percent (1.0%) increase for employees in the classifications of Lieutenant, Fire Inspector, Captain, Assistant Fire Marshall, Battalion Chief, and Fire Marshall, as set forth in Exhibit "C" attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 5. This ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five days after its publication, or publication of a summary thereof, in the City's official newspaper.
