## ORDINANCE NO. 2074

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2060, WHICH CONDEMNED PERMANENT AND TEMPORARY SANITARY SEWER EASEMENTS IN, UNDER, OVER, ALONG, ACROSS, AND UPON PROPERTY LOCATED AT 16423 N.E. 122<sup>ND</sup> STREET AND COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE FEDERSPIEL PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the Redmond City Council passed Ordinance No. 2060 on January 4, 2000, condemning permanent and temporary sanitary sewer easements in, under, over, along, across, and upon the property located at 16423 N.E. 122<sup>nd</sup> Street and commonly known as the Federspiel property, and

WHEREAS, acquisition of the required easements was accomplished through negotiations with the property owners in lieu of condemnation and the City was not required to commence condemnation proceedings, and

WHEREAS, because the required easements have now been acquired, the City Council has decided to repeal the condemnation ordinance, NOW. THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 2060 Repealed. Ordinance No. 2060 of the City of Redmond, passed by the City Council on January 4, 2000, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take

effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.
