

ORDINANCE NO. 2077

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, MAKING ADJUSTMENTS TO CITY
BUDGETS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 2005,
2019, 2030, 2032, 2043, and 2066.

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has identified the need to make certain revisions to the 1999-2000 biennial City budget, and the City Council has reviewed the proposed adjustments and has determined that they should be made, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 2005 adopting the 1999-2000 biennial budget, passed by the City Council on December 8, 1998, and amended by Ordinance No. 2019 on April 6, 1999, and amended by Ordinance No. 2030 on July 6, 1999, and amended by Ordinance No. 2032 on August 16, 1999, and amended by Ordinance No. 2043 on December 7, 1999, and amended by Ordinance No. 2066 on February 15, 2000 is hereby further amended by revising Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 2005, to reflect the increased appropriations set forth in Exhibit 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full. The sources of funds for the additional appropriations are increased grant funds, private contributions, hotel/motel tax, transfers, and building inspection fees.

Section 2. This ordinance, being an administrative action, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.
