CITY OF REDMOND
ORDINANCE NO. 2580

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE REDUCTION OF PEG
CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS FROM COMCAST
CORPORATION AND ITS AFFILIATES, AND THE PEG
GRANT FROM FRONTIER COMMUNICATIONS AND ITS
AFFILIATES WITH RESPECT TO CABLE SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond, Washington (the "City") granted
Vista Television Cable, Inc. ("Vista Television") and Verizon
Northwest, Inc. ("Verizon"), franchises to provide cable television
services in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Vista Television and Verizon Franchises are now
held by Comcast Corporation and its affiliates (all collectively
hereinafter "Comcast") and Frontier Communications and its
affiliates (all collectively hereinafter "Frontier"); and

WHEREAS, Section 9.6 of the Comcast Franchise and Section
6.3.2 of the Frontier Franchise provide for PEG Capital
Contributions from Comcast and the PEG Grant from Frontier; and

WHEREAS, the City may reduce the amount of the PEG Capital
Contributions and PEG Grant or increase them up to \$1.00 per
Subscriber per month; and

WHEREAS, at this time, the City wants to reduce the PEG
Capital Contributions and PEG Grant while reserving its rights to
further reduce or subsequently increase them.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The PEG Capital Contributions from Comcast and the PEG Grant from Frontier are hereby reduced from \$1.00 per Subscriber per month to 35¢ per Subscriber per month; it being specifically understood that the City reserves and retains its rights to further decrease these amounts or increase them back up to a maximum of \$1.00 per Subscriber per month. City Staff is hereby authorized to provide notice of these changes to Comcast and Frontier in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Comcast Franchise and the Frontier Franchise.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary consisting of the title, as provided for by law.

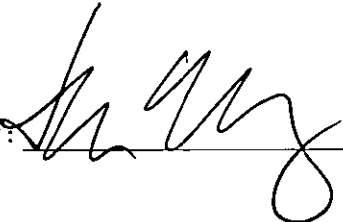
