

RESOLUTION NO. 1115

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING UPON A PETITION FOR VACATION OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, CITY FILE NO. RV 00-001

WHEREAS, a petition for vacation of a right-of-way has been filed with the office of the City Clerk, signed by the owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting the right-of-way to be vacated, which is located within Redmond Mid-Rise Development at the southwest corner of 161st Avenue NE and NE 85th Street, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a public hearing should be held for the purpose of considering said petition for a right-of-way, NOW, THEREFORE,

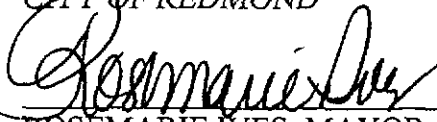
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

A public hearing upon the petition for vacation of a certain public right-of-way located within Redmond Mid-Rise Development at the southwest corner of 161st Avenue NE and NE 85th Street, in the City of Redmond, Washington, City file No. RV 00-001 shall be held in the City Council Chambers at the Redmond Public Safety Building at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard on October 17, 2000, which is not less than 20 days nor more than 60 days from the date of passage of this resolution, at which time all persons interested in said right-of-way vacation are invited to appear and be heard. The City Clerk is directed to post, publish and mail notices of said hearing at least 20 days prior to the date set for hearing, pursuant to

Redmond Community Development Guide Section 20F.20.70 (Public Hearing Notice Requirements).

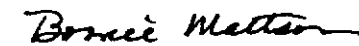
