

RESOLUTION NO. 1170

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, REQUESTING THE FILING OF THE MAYOR'S PRELIMINARY BUDGET WITH THE CITY CLERK NO LATER THAN THE SECOND TUESDAY IN THE SEPTEMBER BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF THE FISCAL BIENNIUM.

WHEREAS, the Council at its March 2003 retreat expressed its desire that the preliminary budget be delivered to the Council by the second Tuesday in the September before the beginning of the fiscal biennium,

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.34.080 stipulates that the Mayor shall prepare a detailed preliminary budget and file the same with the City Clerk at least sixty days before the beginning of the city's next fiscal biennium, and

WHEREAS, the Council and Mayor believe that it is in the best interest of the City to deliver a detailed, comprehensive and balanced budget based upon the best and most complete information available with regards to economic, national and regional issues/events that may affect city finances, and

WHEREAS, the Council and Mayor will continue to meet in the second quarter preceding the upcoming biennium to review emerging issues, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor will work with the Council to allow ample time for its review of the preliminary budget in accordance with the Council's request and state law, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Filing of Preliminary Budget. The Mayor should endeavor to file the preliminary budget with the City Clerk no later than the second Tuesday in the September before the beginning of the City's fiscal biennium. The City Clerk should distribute copies of the budget to the City Council as soon after filing as may be practicable.
