## **RESOLUTION NO. 1203**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING PLANNING DEPARTMENT USER FEE SCHEDULE ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION DELETING THE FEE FOR "PUBLIC PROJECT -ALTERATION OF WILDLIFE HABITAT" IN ORDER TO REFLECT THE DELETION OF THIS PERMIT TYPE BY THE CRITICAL AREAS ORDINANCE UPDATE: MODIFYING THE FEE FOR "SENSITIVE AREAS ORDINANCE EXCEPTION STREETS/UTILITIES" IN ORDER TO REFLECT THE CHANGE OF THE PERMIT ASSOCIATED WITH SUCH FEE FROM A TYPE V PERMIT TO A TYPE II PERMIT; CREATING A NEW PERMIT FEE FOR THE NEW PERMIT, "CRITICAL AREAS ORDINANCE REASONABLE USE - PUBLIC PROJECT," CREATED BY THE CRITICAL AREAS ORDINANCE UPDATE; PROVIDING THAT ALL SUCH FEES SHALL BE **SUBJECT** TO TECHNOLOGY SURCHARGE AND TO PERIODIC INCREASES AS PROVIDED IN ORDINANCE 2090, RESOLUTION 1162, AND RESOLUTION 1189; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution 1189 of the City of Redmond adopted an amended user fee schedule for the Redmond Planning Department effective July 1, 2004, and

WHEREAS, the City's update to its Critical Areas regulations requires that the user fee schedule be amended in order to reflect the deletion of certain permits, the modification of other permits, and the creation of a new permit relating to critical areas, and

WHEREAS, the modified and new permit fees should be subject to the annual adjustments for inflation authorized by Resolution 1189 and to the technology surcharge authorized by City of Redmond Ordinance 2090 and extended by City of Redmond Resolution 1162, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Planning Department User Fee Schedule Amended. The Planning Department User Fee Schedule adopted by City of Redmond Resolution 1189 is hereby amended as follows in order to reflect the City's update of its Critical Areas Regulations and the findings of a user fee study currently under review by the City Council:

- A. The fee for a "Public Project Alteration of Wildlife Habitat" permit is hereby deleted; and
- B. The fee for a "Sensitive Areas Ordinance Exception Streets/Utilities" permit is hereby modified to in order to reflect an amended fee of \$11,875.00 and to recognize a change in permit type from a Type V Permit to a Type II Permit; and
- C. A new fee is added for a "Critical Area Reasonable Use Public Project" permit in the amount of \$5,938.00.

The City Clerk and Director of Planning and Community Development are hereby directed to make such changes in the user fee schedule adopted by Resolution 1189 as are necessary to reflect the amendments adopted in this Section.

Section 2. Inflationary Increases and Technology Surcharge. amended and new fees established by Section 1 of this Resolution are expressly made subject to the authority and process for CPI and other adjustments set forth in Resolution 1189. The amended and new fees are also expressly made subject to the three percent (3%) technology surcharge adopted by Ordinance 2090 and extended by Resolution 1162.

Section 3. Effective Date. The amendments to the Planning Department User Fee Schedule set forth in Sections 1 and 2 above shall become effective upon the effective date of the Critical Areas Ordinance update passed by the Redmond City Council on May 17, 2005.
