

RESOLUTION NO. 1231

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING UPON A REQUEST FOR VACATION OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, CITY FILE NO. L060175.

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WHEREAS, a request for vacation of a portion of NE 83 Street right-of-way, between 161 Avenue NE and 162 Avenue NE, in the Downtown Redmond Transit Center Project, has been made to the City of Redmond, and

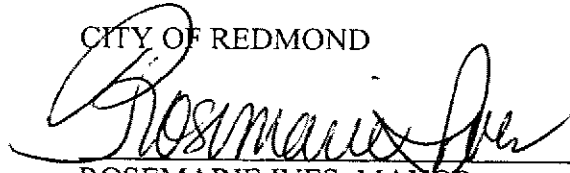
WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a public hearing should be held for the purpose of considering said request for a right-of-way vacation, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

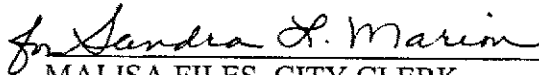
A public hearing upon the request for vacation of a portion of a certain public right-of-way located in the Downtown Redmond Transit Center Project, more specifically a portion of NE 83 Street located between 161 Avenue NE and 162 Avenue NE rights-of-way, in the City of Redmond, Washington, City File No. L060175, shall be held in the City Council Chambers at Redmond City Hall at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard on August 8, 2006, which is not less than 20 days nor more than 60 days from the date of passage of this Resolution, at which time all persons interested in said right-of-way vacation are invited to appear and be heard. The City Clerk is directed to post, publish and mail notices of said hearing at least 20 days

prior to the date set for hearing, pursuant to RCW 35.79.020 and Redmond Community Development Guide Section 20F.30.50.
