WHEREAS, a petition for vacation of a portion of the public right-of-way has been filed with the office of the City Clerk, submitted by IS Property Investments and signed by the owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting the right-of-way to be vacated which is: 160 Avenue NE located between approximately Cleveland Street and the Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) Railway right-of-way, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a public hearing should be held for the purpose of considering said petition for a right-of-way vacation, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

A public hearing upon the petition for vacation of certain public right-of-way known as 160 Avenue NE located between Cleveland Street and the Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) Railway right-of-way, in the City of Redmond, Washington, City File No. L060366, shall be held in the City Council Chambers at the City Hall Building at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard on November 21, 2006, which is not less than 20 days nor more than 60 days from the date of passage of this resolution, at which time all persons interested in said right-of-way vacation are invited to appear and be heard. The City Clerk is directed to post, publish and mail notices of said hearing at least 20 days prior to the date set for hearing, pursuant to RCW 35.79.020.
