A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR THE REHABILITATION AND PRESERVATION OF THE DUDLEY CARTER HAIDA HOUSE AT SLOUGH PARK

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond considers it is in the best public interest to rehabilitate and preserve the Dudley Carter Haida House, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington has approved the 2004 Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan (PRO Plan) that includes the Slough Park/ Dudley Carter Site project, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has set aside \$560,000 in the 2009-2010 Capital Improvement Program for the project, and

WHEREAS, additional funding will help preserve the Haida House, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington is eligible for funds from 4Culture toward the rehabilitation and preservation of the Dudley Carter Haida House

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS

Section 1 The Mayor is hereby authorized to make formal application to the 2009 4Culture Landmark Challenge Grant for funding assistance in the amount of \$25,000

Section 2 Any funding assistance received as the result of this application shall be used for the rehabilitation and preservation of the Dudley Carter Haida House

Section 3 That the City of Redmond's monetary share of the project will be derived from the Capital Improvement Program

Section 4 That this resolution become part of a formal application to 4Culture

Section 5 That the City of Redmond has provided appropriate opportunity for public comment on this application
