A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON APPROVING REDMOND, **AUTHORIZING** THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARCH (A REGIONAL COALITION FOR HOUSING) INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT TO MODIFY **MEMBERSHIP PROVISIONS** FOR ON THE EXECUTIVE BOARD

WHEREAS, City of Redmond was one of the founding members of A Regional Coalition for Housing (ARCH) and approved the Interlocal Agreement with other Eastside cities and King County to create ARCH; and,

WHEREAS, ARCH's purpose is to cooperatively encourage affordable housing on the Eastside; and,

WHEREAS, on January 19, 1993 the City of Redmond approved an amendment to the Interlocal Agreement to enable ARCH to better provide for affordable housing on the Eastside; and,

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement provides for an Executive Board to govern ARCH that is composed of the chief executive officer of each member jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, in order to accommodate the membership of smaller cities with populations of 5,000 persons or less, the ARCH Executive Board has recommended an amendment to the Interlocal Agreement that will allow for shared representation on the Board by the smaller cities; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Council of the City of Redmond approves the amendments to the ARCH Interlocal Agreement in Exhibit A to provide that member cities with populations of less than 5,000 people shall be represented by no more than two chief executive officers from all of these cities.

Section 2: The Mayor, or her designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of the City of Redmond, the necessary amendments to the ARCH Interlocal Agreement.
