RESOLUTION NO. 1122

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING THE CITY OF SEATTLE'S AND OTHER CITIES' REQUEST FOR AN INJUNCTION AGAINST INITIATIVE 722.

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2000, the Redmond City Council adopted Resolution No. 1118 in opposition to Initiative 722, which would nullify certain 1999 tax and fee increases and limit property tax increases (except for new construction) to two percent annually; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2000 the voters in Washington State passed Initiative 722, and

WHEREAS, on Thursday, November 9, 2000, the City of Seattle and other cities filed a complaint for injunctive and declaratory relief against King County, the King County Assessor and the State of Washington to enjoin the implementation and enforcement of Initiative 722, now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES that the City Council of the City of Redmond wishes to express its support for the City of Seattle's and other cities' request for an injunction against Initiative 722.
