RESOLUTION NO. 1132

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, ADDING A NEW SECTION 11 TO RESOLUTION NO. 1129 IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH THAT THE PROVISIONS OF SUCH RESOLUTION REGARDING CONNECTION CHARGES AND CREDITS SHALL NOT APPLY WATER AND TO SEWER CONNECTIONS TO BUILDINGS FOR WHICH A BUILDING PERMIT WAS ISSUED ON OR PRIOR TO JUNE 5, 2001, AND IN ORDER TO FURTHER ESTABLISH THAT THE WATER AND SEWER CONNECTION CHARGES FOR SUCH BUILDINGS SHALL BE THOSE PROVIDED IN RESOLUTIONS NO. 857 AND 795.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1129 of the City of Redmond, passed by the City Council on June 5, 2001, increased the City's water and sewer connection charges, and

WHEREAS, in order to provide equity for those to whom building permits were issued prior to June 5, 2001 but who would otherwise be subject to such increased charges, the City Council has determined that Resolution No. 1129 should be revised to provide for connections to be made upon payment of the connection charges previously in effect, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Connection Charges and Pending Permits. A new Section 11 is hereby added to Resolution No. 1129 to read as follows:

Section 11. Application to Pending Projects. Except as provided in this Section, all provisions of this Resolution No. 1129 shall become effective on June 5, 2001 and shall apply to all water

and sewer connections thereafter made. The provisions of this Resolution shall not apply, however, to initial water and sewer connections made after June 5, 2001 for buildings for which a building permit was issued on or before June 5, 2001, as long as such building permits remain active and are not withdrawn or expire. Water and sewer connections to buildings meeting the requirements of the preceding sentence shall be allowed upon the payment of the fees established by Resolutions No. 857 and 795, provided all other applicable City requirements are met.

Section 2. Effective Date of this Resolution. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
