

RESOLUTION NO. 1149

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR THE PAVED TRAIL AT BEAR CREEK PARK, A PORTION OF THE BEAR & EVANS CREEK TRAIL & GREENWAY PROJECT, TO THE 2002 INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION (IAC) UNDER CHAPTER 43.98A RCW, WASHINGTON WILDLIFE AND RECREATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington has approved the 2000 Feasibility Study Report for the Bear & Evans Creek Trail & Greenway project that identified the need for a paved trail through Bear Creek Park;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington has approved the 1997 Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan (PRO Plan) that includes the Bear & Evans Creek Trail & Greenway project, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington has received 1989 King County Open Space Bond monies for development of the Bear & Evans Creek Trail project, and

WHEREAS, the 1989 King County Open Space Bond funding is not sufficient to complete the Bear & Evans Creek Trail system, and

WHEREAS, if the existing 1989 King County Open Space Bond funding of \$188,768 is combined with a grant of \$180,000 from Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation the total of \$368,768 would be sufficient to develop the Trail at Bear Creek Park, a vital segment of the Bear & Evans Creek Trail project, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Washington Wildlife Recreation Program state and federal funding assistance has been requested to aid in financing the cost of land and facilities for local public bodies; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond considers it is in the best public interest to construct a paved trail through Bear Creek Park in 2003; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON  
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make formal application to the 2002 Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for funding assistance in the amount of \$180,000.

Section 2. Any funding assistance received as the result of this application shall be used in the development of the Trail at Bear Creek Park, a portion of the Bear & Evans Creek Trail.


Section 3. That the City of Redmond's monetary share of the project will be derived from 1989 King County Open Space Bond funds.

Section 4. That the City of Redmond acknowledges that any property acquired or facility developed with Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation financial aid must be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility or habitat conservation area and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the Redmond City Council, the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, and any affected federal agency.

Section 5. That this resolution become part of a formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation.

Section 6. That the City of Redmond has provided appropriate opportunity for public comment on this application.
