

RESOLUTION NO. 1165

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF REDMOND AND THE CITY OF BELLEVUE RELATING TO THE ADJUSTMENT OF A COMMON BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN BELLEVUE AND REDMOND WITHIN THE BELLEVUE-REDMOND ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY.

WHEREAS, a portion of right-of-way along the Bellevue-Redmond Road was dedicated to the City of Redmond as a condition of the Kimura Nursery planned urban development plat; and

WHEREAS, this portion of right-of-way currently lies within the Bellevue city limits; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of both cities to have clear jurisdictional boundaries;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO
RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Interlocal. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute that certain Interlocal Agreement between the City of Redmond and the City of Bellevue relating to the adjustment of a common boundary line between Redmond and Bellevue within the Bellevue-Redmond Road right-of-way, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full.

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ~~BELLEVUE~~ AND THE
CITY OF REDMOND RELATING TO ADJUSTING THEIR COMMON
BOUNDARY WITHIN A PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this day by and between the City of Bellevue, a municipal corporation in the State of Washington (hereinafter referred to as "Bellevue") and the City of Redmond, a municipal corporation in the State of Washington (hereinafter referred to as "Redmond").

WHEREAS, RCW 35.13.310 (1) provides a method to adjust the boundary lines between two cities where the two cities share a common boundary within the right of way of a public street, road, or highway; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.13.310 (2) provides that the councils of any two cities in a situation described in RCW 35.13.310 (1) may enter into an agreement to alter those portions of their boundaries that are necessary to eliminate this situation and create a partial common boundary on either edge of the right of way of the public street, road or highway; and

WHEREAS, an agreement made under RCW 35.13.310 (2) shall include only boundary line adjustments between the two cities that are necessary to eliminate the situation described in RCW 35.13.310 (1); and

WHEREAS, the approval and recording of a Planned Unit Development (hereinafter known as "Kimura Nursery PUD") by and within Bellevue includes property which has been dedicated for right of way along NE Bellevue-Redmond Road (and further legally described below) and as such has created a circumstance as described in RCW 35.13.310 (1); and

WHEREAS, this agreement is authorized by the Interlocal Agreement Act, RCW 39.34;

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has complied with the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act and the City Environmental Procedures Code; and

WHEREAS, a boundary line adjustment under RCW 35.13.310 is not subject to potential review by the Boundary Review Board for King County;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and provisions herein, it is agreed by and between Bellevue and Redmond as follows:

1. The common boundary between Bellevue and Redmond in the right of way of NE Bellevue-Redmond Road is hereby adjusted to place property as

described hereto in Attachment A (Kimura Nursery De-Annexation) within Redmond right of way.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, the parties have caused this agreement to be executed.
