## RESOLUTION NO. 1180

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING LEGISLATIVE ACTION TO PROHIBIT SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES.

WHEREAS, the Washington Clean Indoor Air Act prohibits smoking in public places except for certain facilities that may designate smoking areas; and

WHEREAS, Bars, taverns bowling alleys, tobacco shops and restaurants may be designated smoking areas in their entirety;

WHEREAS, legislation to prohibit smoking in all indoor public places passed the Washington State House Health Care Committee in 2003, but did not become law;

WHEREAS, House Bill 1868 and Senate Bill 5791, prohibiting smoking in all indoor public places, will be considered again by the Washington State legislature during the 2004 legislative session, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES to urge the Washington State Legislature to adopt legislation prohibiting smoking in all indoor public places by passing House Bill 1868 or Senate Bill 5791 or other similar legislation.
