

RESOLUTION NO. 1014

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, JOINING WITH THE BULLITT FOUNDATION IN PLANS FOR "OIL SMART WEDNESDAYS" IN MARCH, 1996

WHEREAS, on March 16, 1993, the City of Redmond adopted the Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) Ordinance which requires employers to encourage and facilitate the reduction of single-occupant vehicle commuting by employees'; and

WHEREAS, the "Oil Smart Wednesdays" campaign is a coalition of business, government, environment, education, neighborhood, recreation, and religious groups challenging us to reduce single-occupant vehicle commuting by employees; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond is a Commuter Challenge Diamond Award winner, and

WHEREAS, the Bullitt Foundation has encouraged the City of Redmond to use "Oil Smart Wednesdays" to broaden participation by City employees in the City's Employee Transportation Program.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. To encourage City of Redmond employees to carpool, ride the bus, bicycle or walk to work on "Oil Smart Wednesdays."


Section 2. To encourage eligible employees when feasible to telecommute on "Oil Smart Wednesdays."

Section 3. To encourage City of Redmond employees to carpool, ride the bus, bicycle or walk to work both during "Oil Smart Wednesdays" and on an on-going basis.

Section 4. To encourage work schedule flexibility for employees wherever possible to make it easier for them to share a ride or use the bus.
