RESOLUTION NO. 1016

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, CERTIFYING THE EXISTENCE OF AN EMERGENCY REQUIRING THE PROCUREMENT OF CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE REPAIR OF THE BELLEVUE - REDMOND ROAD, WAIVING ANY AND ALL BIDDING REQUIREMENTS RELATED TO SUCH REPAIR, AND RATIFYING THE AWARD OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO WATSON ASPHALT PAVING COMPANY, INC. FOR THE REPAIR WORK.

WHEREAS, on February 13, 1996, the street maintenance personnel of the Public Works Department discovered a depression in the paved surface of the Bellevue - Redmond Road approximately 850 feet south of N.E. 40th Street, and

WHEREAS, further investigation of the roadway revealed that joints in a culvert under the roadway have separated and that the resulting infiltration of water and soil from the subsurface of the roadway is severely undermining the roadway structure, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has concluded that additional water from predicted rainfall could result in the complete collapse of the roadway if repairs are not made immediately and before any significant saturation of the subsurface soils and additional flow through the culvert, and

WHEREAS, based upon the potential for roadway failure and the weather forecast for additional rainfall over the Presidents' Day weekend, the Public Works Department ordered

the immediate closure of a portion of Bellevue - Redmond Road and authorized Watson Asphalt Paving Company, Inc., a contractor performing work for the City on other street projects, to immediately proceed with repairs in accord with an estimate provided on February 16, 1996, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined to certify the existence of the emergency pursuant to RCW 35.22.620(6), and to ratify award of a contract for the construction and repair work to Watson Asphalt Paving Company, Inc. without the necessity of complying with bidding procedures, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Certification of Emergency. The Council finds that the facts set forth in the recital paragraphs of this Resolution are true and justify the declaration of an emergency. The Council therefore certifies that an emergency exists requiring the immediate performance of repairs to the Bellevue - Redmond Road approximately 850 feet south of N.E. 40th Street. Without such repairs, the potential exists for the collapse of the roadway structure and the danger of injuries to persons and damage to public and private property.

Section 2. Award of Contract to Watson Asphalt - Waiver of Bidding Requirements. The City Council hereby ratifies the award of a contract to perform the necessary emergency repair work to Watson Asphalt Paving Company, Inc. Any contrary bidding or selection requirements in state law or City ordinance are hereby waived based upon the emergency nature of the work to be performed.
