

RESOLUTION NO. 1029

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DESIGNATING THE SEATTLE TIMES AS THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE CITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PUBLISHING ORDINANCES AND LEGAL NOTICES, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 963

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond is an optional municipal code city organized under the provisions of Title 35A RCW, and

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.21.230 requires each code city to designate an official newspaper by resolution for the purpose of publishing ordinances and other notices required to be published by law, and

WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution No. 963 on January 18, 1994, the City Council designated The Sammamish Valley News, published on a daily basis, as the City's official newspaper, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that The Seattle Times is a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Redmond and has the qualifications prescribed by Chapter 65.16 RCW and RCW 35A.21.230 for official newspapers, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Seattle Times is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the City of Redmond for the purpose of publishing ordinances and other notices required to be published by law.

Section 2. Resolution No. 963, passed by the City Council on January 18, 1994, which designated The Sammamish Valley News as the City's official newspaper, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective on
September 3, 1996.
