

**RESOLUTION NO. 1038**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DECLARING THE RED BRICK SCHOOL STRUCTURE ON THE PROPERTY AT 16600 NE 80TH STREET, KNOWN PRESENTLY AS REDMOND ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, TO BE A BUILDING OF HISTORIC SIGNIFICANCE.

WHEREAS, RCW 19.27.120 permits the designation of a building or structure as having special historical or architectural significance by official action of a legislative body, and

WHEREAS, in January and February of 1997, the City of Redmond evaluated the structure located on the property at 16600 NE 80th Street, commonly known as Redmond Elementary School, for its ability to be designated as a structure of historical significance, and

WHEREAS the results of that evaluation indicated that the building is seventy-five years old, a good example of vernacular institutional architecture, and that it has strong cultural associations and significance through its continual use as a community institution, and

WHEREAS, the structure is the only remaining institution of its type for the period in which it was constructed which is located on the Eastside and as such is locally valuable in the interpretation of that historic period, and

WHEREAS, the structure has maintained enough integrity to yield some information important to the history of Redmond and the surrounding community, and

WHEREAS, if this building is not declared historically significant it could lead to modifications of the structure that would destroy the historic character that the building does retain, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that this historic character is an asset to the community,

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington hereby resolves to declare, pursuant to RCW 19.27.120, the building known presently as Redmond Elementary School to be a building of historic significance to the community of Redmond.
