Restroom Facility at the Redmond Watershed Preserve

RESOLUTION NO. 1046

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR THE RESTROOM FACILITY AT THE REDMOND WATERSHED PRESERVE, TO THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION UNDER CHAPTER 46.09 RCW, NONHIGHWAY / OFF-ROAD VEHICLE ACTIVITIES PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond, Washington has approved the 1996 Redmond Comprehensive Plan and the 1997 Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan (PRO Plan) that includes the Redmond Watershed Preserve, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Washington Wildlife Recreation Program state and federal funding assistance has been requested to aid in financing the cost of land and facilities for local public bodies; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond considers it is in the best public interest to apply for grant funds from the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation under Chapter 46.09 Revised Code of Washington, said funds to be used to construct the restroom facility; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make formal application to the 1997 Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for funding assistance in the amount of \$75,000.

Section 2. Any funding assistance received as the result of this application shall be used in the construction of the restroom facility at the Redmond Watershed Preserve.

Section 3. The City of Redmond anticipates that its local share of the project will be derived from the 1989 King County Open Space Bond.

Section 4. The City of Redmond acknowledges that any property acquired or facility developed with Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation financial aid must be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility or habitat conservation area and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the Redmond City Council, the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, and any affected federal agency.

Section 5. This resolution shall become part of a formal application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation.

Section 6. The City of Redmond has provided appropriate opportunity for public comment on this application.
