## RESOLUTION NO. 1065

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARCH (A REGIONAL COALTION FOR HOUSING) INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT TO AUTHORIZE THE ARCH EXECUTIVE BOARD TO APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE ARCH CITIZEN ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, on January 19, 1993 the City of Redmond entered into an amended Interlocal Agreement with other Eastside cities and King County for purposes of cooperatively providing affordable housing on the Eastside through A Regional Coalition for Housing (ARCH); and,

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement provides for a Citizen Advisory Board, whose members are to be appointed by the City Councils of each ARCH member jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, in order to provide for more efficient procedures for appointing new members to the Citizens Advisory Board, the ARCH Executive Board, which is composed of the chief executive officers from each ARCH member jurisdiction, has recommended an amendment to the Interlocal Agreement which would authorize the ARCH Executive Board to appoint new members to the Citizen Advisory Board; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That in order to provide for more efficient procedures for appointing new members to the Citizen Advisory Board, the Mayor, or her designee, is

hereby authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of the City of Redmond, necessary amendments to the ARCH Interlocal Agreement which would authorize the ARCH Executive Board to appoint members to the ARCH Citizen Advisory Board.
