A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 916 REGARDING THE FEES FOR ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES RELATED TO ANIMAL CONTROL AND REMOVING SAID FEES FROM THE SCHEDULE OF USER FEES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1480 of the City of Redmond provides that all administrative fees shall be set by Council resolution, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 916 adopted by the City Council on November 17, 1992 amended the City's schedule of user fees to include the fees for various animal control administrative services, including dog and cat licensing and other animal related licenses, and

WHEREAS, the City Council upon the recommendation of the City Clerk has determined that said fees for animal control administrative services should be removed from the City's schedule of user fees, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an agreement with King County, the City's fees for animal control services should be consistent with those of the County, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES A FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Animal Control Licensing Fee Schedule. The fees, administrative charges, and costs set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full is hereby adopted.

Section 2. The fees for animal control administrative services are hereby removed from the City's schedule of user fees.
