

RESOLUTION NO. 5.

WHEREAS, the Department of Highways of the State of Washington, is desirous of constructing State Road No. 2 on each side of and through the Town of Redmond and is desirous of routing the traffic on said State Road through the Town of Redmond over First Avenue from the north corporate limits of said town to Jackson Street; thence southeasterly to the south corporate limits of said town, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Highways of the State of Washington is desirous of receiving Federal Aid for the improvement of said State Road, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Public Roads of the Department of Agriculture of the United States of America will not participate in the construction of said State Road until and unless the Town of Redmond will agree to refrain from permitting encroachments upon the right of way of said State Road within the corporate limits of said town, and until and unless the Town of Redmond will agree to refrain from passing ordinances or laws fixing a speed limits of under 25 miles per hour upon and along said State Road, and until and unless the Town of Redmond will agree to refrain from erecting signs, semaphores and signals that will give preference to local routes or that will hinder or delay traffic upon and along said State Road within the corporate limits of said town;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Redmond, that, for and in consideration of the Department of Highways of the State of Washington and the Bureau of Public Roads of the Department of Agriculture of the United States of America constructing said State Road and routing traffic on the same through the Town of Redmond over First Avenue from the north corporate limits of said town to Jackson Street thence southeasterly to the south corporate limits of said town, it hereby agrees with the Department of Highways of the State of Washington and the Bureau of Public Roads of the Department of Agriculture of the United States of America that it will not, in the future, permit encroachments on the right of way of said State Road within the corporate limits of said town, nor will it pass any ordinances or laws fixing a speed limit of under 25 miles per hour on said State Road within the corporate limits of said town, nor will it allow the erection of signs, semaphores and signals that will give preference to local routes which intersect with said State Road, nor will it slow up, hinder or delay traffic on said State Road within the corporate limits of said town.
