

RESOLUTION No. 50.

TO: Director of Highways,
State of Washington,
Olympia, Washington.

Whereas, certain excess waters flowing down a hill near the North end of the Town limits have been forced to collect on and around a certain area known as First Avenue (Also, known as State Primary Highway #2 North), and said water, having no outlet, backs up, thereby badly flooding the property and basements of nearby landowners, and

Whereas, this flooding causes a serious hazard to traffic, and

Whereas, this flooding could be easily remedied by the construction of a culvert under said State Primary Highway #2 North, and the water then channeled into an already existing ditch, and

Whereas, a great deal of rain-water and surface water collects on and along the said State Primary Highway #2 North, in or near the center of the Town of Redmond, causing a serious hazard to traffic and a continuous harassment to pedestrians, and

Whereas, this situation could easily be remedied by the construction of storm sewers, or some other economical dispersal method,

Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Redmond hereby petition the Director of Highways of the State of Washington, to the end that he lend his aid in remedying the dangerous conditions existing today in the Town of Redmond.
