

RESOLUTION NO 58

WHEREAS, The Water Revenue Construction Funds of the Town of Redmond are depleted and it is vitally in the interests of the Town that a certain bill be paid which has been presented on such funds,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the TOWN OF REDMOND,

1. That the Town Treasurer is hereby authorized to transfer from the Current Expense Funds the ^{sum} of \$1010.00 to be placed to the credit of the following Funds;

2. That the Town Treasurer is hereby authorized to transfer from the Current Expense Funds to the following Departments:

the sum of ^{To WATER Funds for} \$ 1000.00 electric power, \$50.00 police court expense \$ 150.00 library expense, \$65.00 dog pound expense, \$450.00 Town Hall expense, \$1600.00 police department, OASI, industrial insurance & medical aid 350.00.)

3. That the Town Clerk is hereby authorized to make payment of \$ 1010.00 out of Water Revenue Constuction Funds.
