

TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO 61

A RESOLUTION declaring the intention of the Town Council to order the construction of a sidewalk on the south side of Kirkland street in the Town of Redmond from the east line of Union street to the east line of Adair street and on the east side of Adair street from the south line of Kirkland street to the north line of Jackson street; providing that the costs of such improvement shall all be borne by the abutting property owners with the exception of a portion crossing three, 16 foot alleys and fixing the time and place for hearing on this resolution.

Be it ordained by THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 177 of the 1949 session of the State of Washington, it is the intention of the Town Council of the Town of Redmond to order the construction of a concrete sidewalk on the south side of Kirkland Street in the Town of Redmond from the east line of Union street to the west line of Adair street and on the east side of Adair street from the south line of Kirkland street to the north line of Jackson Street. All of the costs of such improvement shall be borne by the abutting property owners and assessments shall be made against said abutting property in accordance with law, with the exception that the cost of constructing such sidewalk across the 16 foot alley presently located between lot 11 and 10 of Block 4, and the 16 foot alley located between lot 14 and 13 of Block 3 and the 16 foot alley located on the west side of Adair between lot 1 and 25 of Block 2 of Sikes third addition, King County Washington, shall be borne by the Town out of funds presently on hand.

Section 2. A hearing shall be held on this resolution at 8:00 clock p.m. on the 23th day of September, 1953, in the Council chambers, Town Hall, Redmond Washington, at which hearing the Council shall hear persons for and against the improvement, and determine whether it will or will not proceed with the improvement and whether it will make any changes in the original plan, and what the changes shall be.

Section 3. The town Clerk shall cause this resolution to be published in the Sammamish Valley News on September 11, 1953, and the Town Clerk shall give notice of the date of such hearing, at least ten days before the date fixed for such hearing, to each owner or reputed owner of the abutting property by mailing to the owner or reputed owner of the property as shown on the tax rolls of the County Treasurer at the address shown thereon a notice of the date of hearing.
