RESOLUTION NO. 65

A RESOLUTION fixing the date of hearing on the Assessment Roll for the construction of the sidewalk on the south side of Kirkland Street in the Town of Redmond from a point 142 feet east of the east line of First Avenue to the west line of Union Street.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 60 passed the 9th day of September, 1953, ordered the construction of a concrete sidewalk on the south side of Kirkland Street in the Town of Redmond from a point 142 feet east of the east line of First Avenue to the west line of Union Street; and

WHEREAS, the Town Engineer has made his final report of the construction work performed in making the improvement provided for by said resolution and the Town Council has accepted the work and approved the report; and

WHEREAS, the Town Engineer has filed the Assessment Roll for said improvement with the Town Clerk, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. The 11th day of November, 1953, at 8:00 o'clock p.m. in the Council Chambers at the Town Hall, Redmond, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for hearing on the Assessment Roll for the sidewalk improvement under Resolution No. 60 and the Town Clerk be and he is hereby directed to give legal notice of the hearing and the time and place thereof by publication and mailing in the manner provided by law.
