RESOLUTION NO. 66

A RESOLUTION fixing the date of hearing on the assessment Roll for the construction of a sidewalk on the south side of Kirkland street from Union street to Adair street and on the east side of Adair street from the south side of Kirkland street to the north line of Jackson street in the Town of Redmond, Washington.
