

RESOLUTION *Nº 72*

WHEREAS, the Town of Redmond, Washington did acquire certain lands for the purpose of garbage disposal, said lands being described as follows:

That portion of the east 60 feet of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 31, Township 26 North, Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian lying between County Road known as Novelty Road No. 555 on the south and the County Road known as Peterson Road on the north, being a distance of 560 feet, more or less, and

WHEREAS, the city did for a number of years use said property for garbage disposal, and did so use this land for that purpose until it could no longer be so used, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Redmond no longer needs said lands for the purpose of garbage disposal or for any other town purpose,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Redmond, a municipal corporation acting by and through its duly elected, qualified and acting council and mayor does hereby authorize the conveyance of the above described property to one Helen Turcotte, a single woman and does direct its duly authorized officers to issue a deed to one Helen Turcotte, a single woman, upon payment of the purchase price agreed upon.

Be It Further Resolved by this council that this Resolution shall be retroactive and be considered effective from 15 April 1953.
