

RESOLUTION 8

A RESOLUTION authorizing William Brown, the Mayor of the Town of Redmond, to sign and execute any agreements or instruments on behalf of the Town of Redmond with the State of Washington and/or the United States of America and any of their agencies in connection with the replacement of the existing wooden water mains by cast iron mains, and the procuring of money and sale of bonds therefor.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond that William Brown, the Mayor of said Town, shall be and hereby is empowered, authorized and directed to sign and execute on behalf of said Town and as its official representative and agent, with full power so to do, any and all agreements and instruments required to be signed or entered into with the State of Washington and/or the United States of America, and any of their agencies or subdivisions, in connection with the replacement by the Town of its existing wooden water mains with cast iron mains, and in connection with the procuring of money therefor and the disposal of the Water Revenue Bonds heretofore voted by the Town of Redmond.
