

Resolution No. 833

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE SITING  
OF A PROPOSED PERMANENT KING COUNTY  
JAIL

---

WHEREAS, the capacity of existing detention facilities within King County is insufficient to meet future demands; and,

WHEREAS, one of the facilities which will be needed first is a new Adult Detention facility; and,

WHEREAS, the placement of a new, permanent Adult Detention facility in Northeast King County may be appropriate if the proposed site is identified through a fair and rigorous process with consideration of programmatic as well as structural alternatives and if the environmental impacts of siting the facility are fully disclosed and mitigated; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond welcomes the participation of other Northeast and Eastside municipalities in the discussion of how to best serve the needs of our growing population through the placement of detention facilities; and,

WHEREAS, representatives of the news media have wrongly conveyed our willingness to discuss this matter as having, "entered into a bidding war" for the placement of the Permanent Jail; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,  
DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. The City of Redmond will neither seek nor campaign for the placement of the permanent jail within the City of Redmond nor in unincorporated areas adjacent thereto.

Section 2. If other municipalities perceive it to be in the interests of their constituents and the region to seek the placement of the permanent jail within their own corporate limits the City of Redmond will support that decision.
