RESOLUTION NO. 836

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE 148TH AVENUE N.E. EXTENSION PROJECT, REJECTING THE APPARENT LOW BID AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT TO THE NEXT LOWEST BIDDER.

WHEREAS, on April 19, 1990, the bids were opened for construction of the 148th Avenue N.E. extension project no. 86-BD-36, and within the time allotted by the governing bid specifications, the apparent low bidder, R.W. Scott Construction Company, informed the City Engineer that a material mistake had been made in preparing its bid, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer reviewed the bid and the claimed mistake and determined that a material mistake had been made in preparing the bid and that the bidder was entitled to withdraw his bid pursuant to the governing bid specifications, and therefore recommends that the City Council reject such bid and award the construction contract to the next lowest bidder, David A. Mowat Company, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The bid for construction of the 148th Avenue N.E. extension project no. 86-BD-36, submitted by R.W. Scott Construction Company should be, and is hereby rejected.

Section 2. The contract for construction of the 148th Avenue N.E. extension project is hereby awarded to David A. Mowat

Company in accord with its bid in the amount of \$4,689,710.00 plus applicable sales tax.
