**RESOLUTION NO. 846**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNATE TO SIGN ALL APPLICATIONS, GRANT AGREEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS, AND OTHER DOCUMENTS RELATING TO OIL/WATER SEPARATOR FACILITIES PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTION GRANTS.

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WHEREAS, the City of Redmond intends to develop a plan for and undertake a program of planning, design, and construction relating to removal of oil and grease from stormwater in the downtown area of the City of Redmond, and such a plan being necessary to comply with state water quality standards for the Sammamish River and to protect the environment, and

WHEREAS, the plan is to be developed in accordance with the requirements of WAC 173-240-050 and 060, and will set forth the plans for the facilities required to be constructed to serve the needs of the area, and

WHEREAS, the costs of the planning, design, and construction of the stormwater pollution control facilities are eligible for state funding, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor or her designate is duly authorized to sign applications, Grant Agreements and Amendments, and other documents relating to stormwater pollution control facilities planning, design, and construction grants.

Section 2. The manager and senior engineer of the Stormwater Division of Public Works are duly authorized to sign payment requests made to the grantor agency.
