

RESOLUTION NO. 863

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, JOINING WITH THE SEATTLE KING COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL IN PLANS FOR OIL SMART WEDNESDAYS IN MARCH

WHEREAS, the Seattle King County Economic Development Council is the host organization for the Commuter Challenge program, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle King County Economic Development Council has joined with other organizations in support of the Bullitt Foundation's plans for "Oil Smart Wednesdays" (March 6, 13, 20, and 27), and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond is a Commuter Challenge Pacesetter organization, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle King County Economic Development Council has encouraged the City of Redmond to use "Oil Smart Wednesday" to broaden participation by City employees in the City's Employee Transportation Program.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. To encourage all City of Redmond employees to rideshare, take the bus, walk or bike to work on "Oil Smart Wednesday."

Section 2. To encourage City of Redmond employees to ride-share both during "Oil Smart Wednesday" and on an on-going basis.

Section 3. To encourage work schedule flexibility for employees wherever possible to make it easier for them to share a ride OR use the bus,

Section 4. To encourage employees when feasible to telecommute and work at home on "Oil Smart Wednesday."

Section 5. To encourage work schedule flexibility so that commuters can travel earlier or later so there will be less wasted time and fuel due to congestion during the peak commuting periods.

Section 6. To encourage employees to wear a green ribbon on "Oil Smart Wednesday" as a reminder to others to be conscious of Oil Smart practices.

Section 7. To encourage employees to display green ribbons on their car pool or vanpool on "Oil Smart Wednesday" as a reminder to others to be conscious of Oil Smart practices.
