

RESOLUTION NO. 881

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON IN SUPPORT
OF STATE ROUTE 520 SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) initiated improvements to State Route (SR)520 from SR901 to SR202, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond supports the construction of the SR520 improvements, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has worked with the Washington State Department of Transportation and other participants in the planning and financing of the SR520 improvements, and

WHEREAS, construction of the SR520 improvements are estimated to not occur until beyond 1992, and

WHEREAS, the volume of traffic on this state highway has steadily increased to an approximate level of 43,500 cars each weekday, and

WHEREAS, accidents on this state highway have also steadily increased, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond is expressly concerned for safety along this state highway and that additional accidents will occur before the SR520 improvements are implemented, now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. To encourage the Washington State Department of Transportation to seek immediate interim solutions to reduce the number of accidents on this State Highway.

Section 2. To encourage the Washington State Department of Transportation to begin construction of a wider bridge structure as soon as possible as a means of reducing traffic accidents.
