A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,  
SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING UPON A  
PETITION FOR VACATION OF A CERTAIN  
PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY  
OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, CITY FILE  
NO. MISC91-0002.

WHEREAS, a petition for vacation of a right-of-way has been filed with the office of the City Clerk, signed by the owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting the right-of-way to be vacated, which is located generally at the north half of N.E. 32 Street between 174 Avenue N.E. and 175 Court N.E., and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a public hearing should be held for the purpose of considering said petition for a right-of-way vacation, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

A public hearing upon the petition for vacation of a certain public right-of-way located generally at the north half of N.E. 32 Street south of and between 174 Avenue N.E. and 175 Court N.E., in the City of Redmond, Washington, City File No. MISC91-0002, shall be held in the City Council Chambers at the Redmond City Hall at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on February 18, 1992, which is not less than 20 days nor more than 60 days from the date of passage of this resolution, at which time all persons interested in said right-of-way vacation are invited


to appear and be heard. The City Clerk is directed to post, publish and mail notices of said hearing at least 20 days prior to the date set for hearing, pursuant to Redmond Community Development Guide Section 20F.20.070(15)(b).
