

RESOLUTION NO. 891

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING THE KING COUNTY
REGIONAL HOUSING LEVY OF MARCH 10, 1992

WHEREAS, recent statistics show that nearly 10,000 King County residents have no place to call home, and an additional 75,000 residents are at risk of losing their homes, and

WHEREAS, the majority of this at-risk population is composed of children, seniors, working families, victims of domestic violence and the newly un-employed, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond advocates providing housing assistance to persons in need, through its support of human services programs, and,

WHEREAS, the King County Regional Housing Levy will generate \$150 million to create housing units which will provide more affordable housing opportunities, and will benefit 77,000 King County families over the next 30 years,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND WASHINGTON, DOES
RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

To support the passage of the King County Regional Housing Levy on March 10, 1992, in order that more affordable housing opportunities may be created in the region and in the City of Redmond.
