

RESOLUTION NO. 91.

WHEREAS, the United States of America has petitioned the Town Council of the Town of Redmond for vacation of a portion of a public street in said Town (Being the most easterly part of 95th Street) and particularly described as follows:

All of the NE 95th Street lying east of a line parallel with and 490 feet west of the east line of the north half of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 25 north, Range 5 east, W.M., King County, Washington. Also that 30 foot road adjacent to and east of Lots 8, 9 and 10, and that 30 foot road adjacent to and south of Lots 10, 11, 12, 13 14, and the east 48.64 feet of Lot 15 thereof, being in and according to the plat of L. K. Richardson, Addition No. 1 to the City of Redmond, according to the plat recorded in Volume 56 of Plats, page 59, records of King County, Washington.

WHEREAS, the Laws of the State of Washington require (RCW35.79.010 et. seq.) that a public hearing on said petition be set no less than 20 days nor more than 60 days from this date, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Redmond, Washington that 8 P.M. on the 22nd day of January, 1958 at the Council Chambers, Town Hall, Redmond, Washington is the time and place for public hearing on the said petition for vacation of the above described street, and the Town Clerk is hereby ordered to post such notices as may be required under the law.
